

SAKATA INX Group Environmental Management Standards for Chemical Substances

(Purpose)

Article 1 To provide high-quality, safe, and environmentally friendly products that contribute to the sustainable development of society by reducing the burden on people and the environment caused by hazardous substances in the overall business activities of the SAKATA INX Group (including overseas affiliated companies), and to establish the Environmental Management Standards for Chemical Substances.

2. “Environmental Management Standards for Chemical Substances” in Procurement Guidelines shall be these Standards.

(Scope of Application)

Article 2 All materials used for all products and outsourced products in the SAKATA INX Group and all materials used by our clients (including sub-materials, packaging, etc.) shall be the scope.

(Management standard)

Article 3

- (1) The SAKATA INX Group prohibited substances, Regulated substances by each company of the group, and Self-controlled substances by each company of the group are specified.

Standard 1: Substances prohibited by the SAKATA INX Group

The SAKATA INX Group prohibits the following substances for intentional use:

- Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants
(Common name, abbreviation: POPs convention, the Stockholm convention)
Substances listed in the Annex A, B and C
- Rotterdam Convention on the Prior Informed Consent Procedure for Certain Hazardous Chemicals and Pesticides in International Trade
(Common name, abbreviation: Rotterdam convention, PIC convention)
Substances listed in the Annex III

Standard 2: Regulated substances by each company of the group

Each company of the SAKATA INX Group complies with the chemical and environmental regulations of its own country related to the materials used.

Standard 3: Voluntarily controlled substances by each company of the group

Each company of the SAKATA INX Group manages chemical substances subject to industry self-regulation, client guidelines, etc. according to their product use.

(2) Operation

1. Each company of the SAKATA INX Group identifies and manages regulations and regulatory requirements related to its business activities (chemical substance regulation, environmental regulation, industry self-regulation, and client guidelines) in a separate table. (The table is for internal use only.)
2. The Environment & Quality Division of SAKATA INX CORPORATION reviews prohibited substances in (1) as necessary.
