Continued Inclusion in the FTSE Blossom Japan Index and FTSE Blossom Japan Sector Relative Index

SAKATA INX CORPORATION (Headquarters: Chuo-ku, Osaka; Representative Director, President & CEO: Yoshiaki Ueno; Securities Code: 4633) is pleased to announce that it has been selected as a constituent of the FTSE Blossom Japan Index for the third consecutive year and the FTSE Blossom Japan Sector Relative Index for the fifth consecutive year.

The FTSE Blossom Japan Index is prepared by FTSE Russell, a global index provider, and has been designed to measure the performance of companies in environmental, social and governance (ESG) practices. It is widely used for the creation and evaluation of sustainable investment funds and other financial instruments. FTSE Russell evaluations are based on performance in areas such as Corporate Governance, Health & Safety, Anti-Corruption and Climate Change. Businesses included in the FTSE Blossom Japan Index meet a variety of environmental, social and governance criteria.

The FTSE Blossom Japan Sector Relative Index is designed to be sector neutral, and reflects the relative performance of Japanese companies that excel in environmental, social and governance (ESG) performance in their respective sectors. In order to promote the transition to a low-carbon economy, only those companies with particularly high GHG emissions that are recognized for their improvement efforts by the TPI Management Quality Score are included in the index.

The FTSE Blossom Japan Index and FTSE Blossom Japan Sector Relative Index have been adopted by the Government Pension Investment Fund (GPIF) as ESG investment benchmarks. SAKATA INX has also been selected for the S&P/JPX Carbon Efficient Index, one of the ESG indices for Japanese equities adopted by GPIF.

To realize its long-term strategic vision, “SAKATA INX VISION 2030,” the SAKATA INX Group is addressing key sustainability issues, including responding to climate change, reducing environmental impacts, creating a workplace where diverse talent can thrive, and strengthening corporate governance and risk management. Through its business activities, the Group will continue to contribute to the realization of a sustainable society and strive to further enhance corporate value.
